

14 April Day 01: ARRIVAL

Arrival in Kathmandu airport, you will be met by our representative at the airport to transfer you to you hotel.

15 April Day 02: KATHMANDU (B)

AM: sightseeing at Patan Durbar Square, Swayambhunath and Boudhanath

Patan is also known as Lalitpur or the "city of fine arts" and is the oldest city in the valley. This Buddhist City is said to have been founded by Emperor Ashoka in the 3rd century BC. Patan is the cradle of arts and architecture of the valley, a great center both of the Newari Buddhist religion and of traditional arts & crafts with 136 bahals or courtyards and 55 major temples. Well known among these are the Krishna Mandir, Hiranya Varna Mahavihar, Kumbheshwar temple and Kumari temple. *Orthodox Himalayan Tea tasting if interested*

Swayambunath is an ancient religious complex atop a hill in the Kathmandu Valley, west of Kathmandu city. The Buddhist stupa this is said to be 2000 years old. The stupa which forms the main structure is composed of a solid hemisphere of brick and earth supporting a lofty conical spire capped by a pinnacle of copper gilt. Painted on the four sided base of the spire are the all-seeing eyes of Lord Buddha. This hill is a mosaic of small Chaityas and Pagoda temples.




Boudhanath: It is one of the largest stupas in South Asia, and it has become the focal point of Tibetan Buddhism in Nepal.

16 April Day 03: KATHMANDU – CHITWAN (B,L,D)

Earl morning: Drive to Chitwan (165 km / 5 hrs). En route visit Manakamana in Cable Car Lunch will be served upon arrival.

17 April Day 04: CHITWAN (B,L,D)

Full day jungle activities including elephant back safari in search of animals, reptiles, birds and other denizens of the jungle.

18 April Day 05: CHITWAN – BANDIPUR (B)

Drive to Bandipur (95 km / 3 hrs)

Bandipur is an ancient trading town of quaint streets and charming atmosphere. Bandipur is a living museum of Newari culture, a beautifully preserved village crowning a lofty ridge above the highway stop of Dumre. Visit the village and mingle with the locals.

19 April Day 06: BANDIPUR – POKHARA (B)

Upon arrival at Pokhara, check-in at hotel.

Pokhara: Pohkara is famous for its lake and its amazing views of the Annapurna range include Annapurna I and VI, Annapurna South and Machhapuchhre. Early morning drive around 30 minute to reach Sarankot from there you can see the very panoramic view of the mountain, truly a photographers paradise



PM: Local sightseeing in Pokhara visiting Davi's fall, Bindyabasini temple, International Mountain Museum and a boating on Fewa Lake.

20 April Day 07: POKHARA – AUSTRAILAN BASE CAMP (B,L,D)

Drive from Pokhara to Kande. We walk through forest on uphill rugged trail. A walk of about an hour will take us to the Australian Camp (Thulo Kharka) for overnight stay. The elevation of the place is 2000m. It offers the mesmerizing views of the major peaks of the Annapurna range including the famous Mt. Machapuchre, Dhaulagiri, and Lamjung Himal in the east. Overnight at the lodge.

21 April Day 08: AUSTRAILAN BASE CAMP – POKHARA (B,D)

Should the weather permits we can ask our trek guide to give the early morning wake up call to see the sunrise views over the aforesaid mountains. After having breakfast around 9:00 AM we take a return journey to Pokhara and walk to Kande on rugged trail through bushy vegetation and walk down to Kande where we will be picked up by the vehicle to drive back to Pokhara. Walking time will be around 2 - 3 hrs.

22 April Day 09: POKHARA – PATALEBAN (B,D)

25 April Day 12: KATHMANDU (B)

Full day sightseeing at Bhaktapur Durbar Sqaure and Siddharth Art Gallery.

Bhaktapur: Also known as city of devotees, Bhaktapur is the home of medieval art and architecture. Lying 14 kilometers/9 miles east of Kathmandu City, this place was founded in the 9th Century and is shaped like a conch shell.

Visit of Baber Mahal Revisited (meeting local contemporary artists). It is a heritage complex of renovated Rana palace with a unique blend of European, Indian and local architecture. It houses boutiques and art gallery. Here we also visit Siddhartha Art Gallery www.siddharthaartgallery.com

Established in 1987, the contemporary art gallery has put on over 300 exhibitions to date by artists from Nepal and further afield. Having participated in several community arts projects, Siddhartha aims to exhibit art that addresses socio-cultural and political issues Interact with the artists over a cup of coffee.
